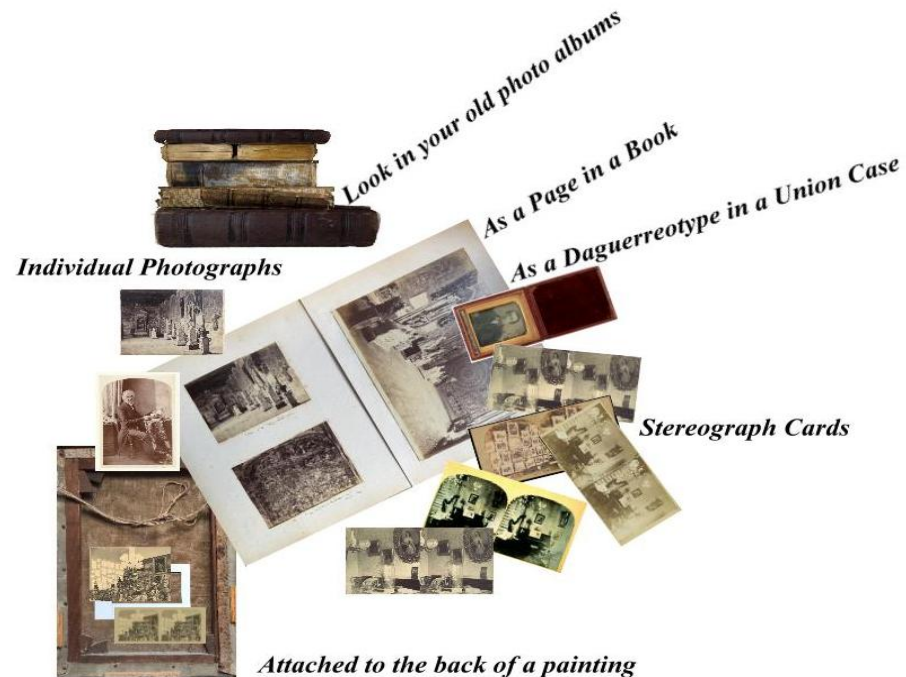

A Search For a Photograph Of Hobart Art Treasures Exhibition of 1858

What to look for:



ARTIST'S IMPRESSION of the photograph next to the left of the 'Illustrated News of the World' engraving
Artist's impression of the photo of the area on the left of the engraving



View looking towards Northwest corner of the Hobart Legislative Council Chamber



Engraving: 'After a photograph' of the Northeast corner of the chamber

There were probably at least four photos of the 1858 Hobart exhibition.
One was engraved for 'The Illustrated News of the World', a view of the Northeast corner of the chamber.
The one I am looking for is the one to the left of the engraving; a view of the Northwest corner.

What to Look For

Look for a photo with the same general layout as the engraving. Look for similar room features; ceiling, cornice, architrave and chandelier. The artist's impression is only a guide to show three areas of interest;

- Background - paintings on the wall.
- Middle layer - statues and small items on tables just in front of the paintings.
- Foreground - people viewing.

Look for albumen photos on thin paper stuck to album pages or two images side by side on card as a stereograph. It will probably be a faded monochrome image but a hand tinted image is possible. If you own original artworks from the exhibition look at the back to see if the photo has been attached.

If your photo satisfies that condition I will notify you and ask for a certified copy for which I will reimburse expenses. On receipt of a certified copy I will pay the reward into a bank account specified by you. You do not need to make any formal claim.
